



MHOFU – FERRY – KARIBA TOWN, ZIMBABWE

Trip Costs per ferry – we don't charge for individual vehicles.

Kariba town to Changa/Fothergill (or Changa/Fgill to Kariba) – U\$500 per trip

Kariba town to Tashinga (or Tashinga to Kariba) – U\$950 per trip

Price *EXCLUDES* all National Parks lake usage fees and VAT.

We do not provide any meals or beverages.

Maximum number of vehicles on the vessel – 4 (bakkie size) (or 2 vehicles with trailers)

Weight restrictions per vehicle – normal light 4x4 vehicles – no restrictions

Frequency of trips – Totally dependent on demand, no set dates of travel.

Travel time – Kariba to Changa/Fothergill – approximately 3½ hours
(depending on weather/lake conditions) – one way

Kariba to Tashinga – approximately 6 hours (depending on weather/lake conditions) – one way

Vehicle Insurance requirements – all vehicles to be fully covered by vehicle owner – we are covered for the vessel and passengers only.

Nearest camping type accommodation day before trip – Kariba town – Lomagundi Lakeside have a camp site and self-catering lodges with a pub & restaurant, or Warthogs Safari Camp have similar.

Option to stay at Tashinga camp then drive to Changa/Fothergill pick up point for boarding ferry travelling back to Kariba town.

Please note, the ferry has a very basic ablution for passengers and a top deck for seating, again very basic (own chairs).
